PATHS TO GRADUATING WITH PRACTICAL SKILLS



1.) WORK EXPERIENCE PATH

If the student has work experience (either paid or internship) or own a business, they need to bring an official reference letter from their previous or current workplace or provide evidence of their business revenue to show they have practical skills needed to graduate

ALTERNATIVE PATHS

If the student is not meeting Path 1 criteria, they have the option to choose from Internship Path or Entrepreneurship Path in order to fully graduate

2) ENTREPRENEURSHIP PATH

If the student chooses this path they will need to go through a month to 3 months internship/training program (paid or unpaid). The student can either send their CV to Academic Head to find the suitable company for them to join or they can find the internship program of their choice by themselves. In either case, they need to attend CV/Interview/Design Thinking Workshops



STAGES OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP PATH

Stage 1) attend Workshops (Design thinking and CV/Interview Skills Workshops)

Stage 2) attend specific training or internship and or design a solid proposal for a StartUp plan
